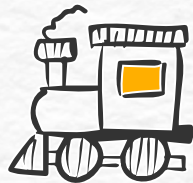
how to reach?

DAY-0

Tour Begins!

Departure from Delhi to Jibhi



- 📍 The group will assemble at the pick-up point by 7:00 PM (tentative)
- 📍 We'll meet the team captains and a small tour briefing session will be conducted.
- 📍 After which, we'll head out on an overnight journey to Aut.

Note: The pickup point would be Majnu Ka Tila (tentative).

DAY-1

- 🎯 The travellers who opted for a Bike Trip will head down to Manali to collect their bikes, followed by a test run. After which, they will head to Jibhi as well.
- 🎯 Upon reaching Jibhi, we will check into our designated hotel where we will have dinner and spend the night.

DAY-2

Departure to Chitkul via Kinnaur Valley

Explore Snow Covered Meadows at Jalori Pass

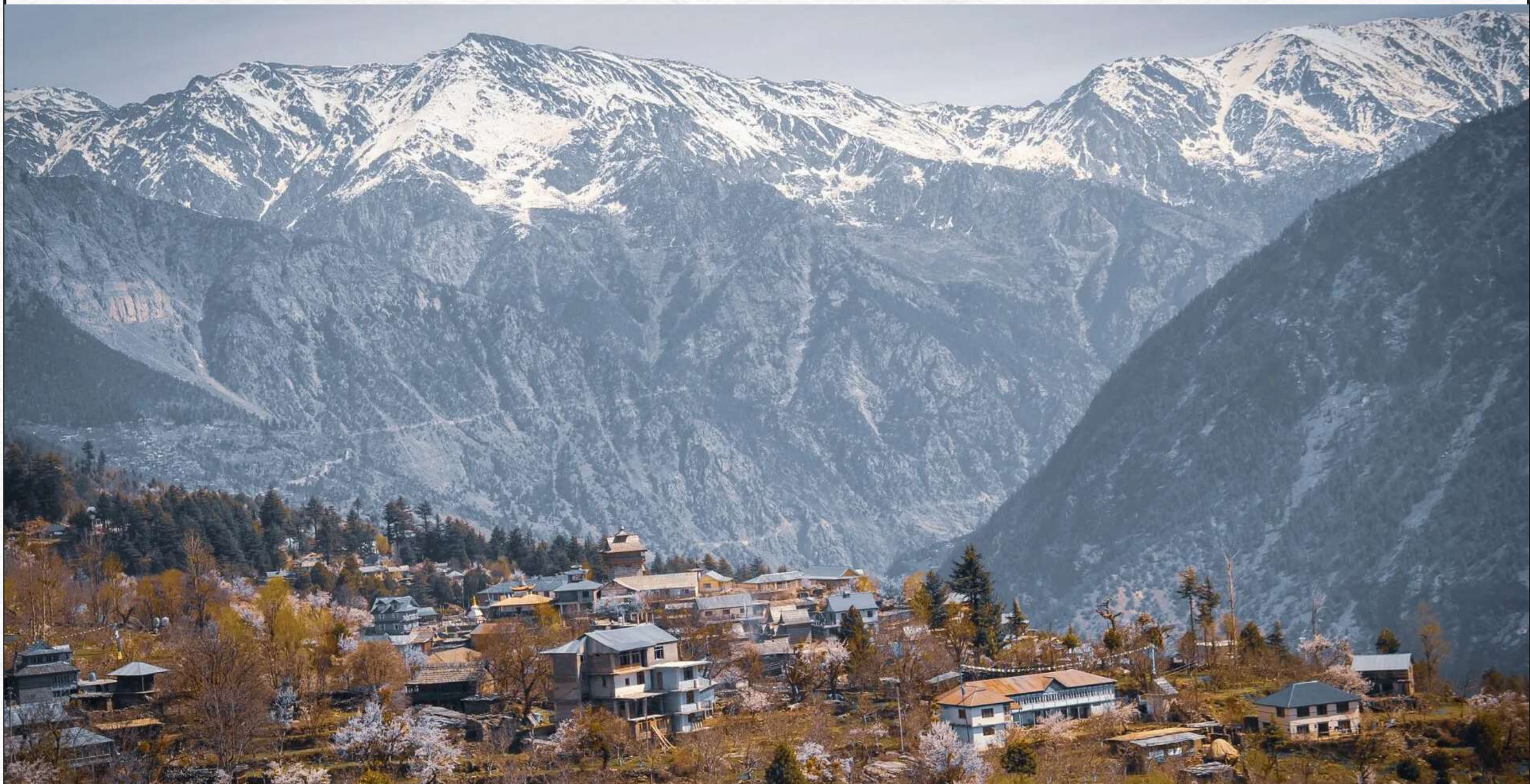


- 🎯 After spending a peaceful night and waking up to the sound of birds chirping, we will have breakfast. We'll check out of the hotel and head towards Chitkul, the Last Village on the India–China Border also renowned for the popular Hindustan Ka Aakhri Dhaba.
- 🎯 En route to Chitkul, we'll be traversing Jalori Pass as well as witnessing extremely beautiful views of mountains, valleys, and green meadows.
- 🎯 Upon reaching Chitkul, we will check into our respective Hotels.
- 🎯 Dinner followed by an overnight stay in Chitkul.

DAY-3

Explore Chitkul - Transfer to Kalpa

Overnight Stay at Kalpa



- 📍 After breakfast, we will head towards Kalpa which is known for its scenic landscapes
- 📍 En-route Kalpa, the small town of Reckong Peo serves as the perfect pit stop. If the weather gods are in your favour, you will be able to catch a glimpse of Kinner Kailash Peak.
- 📍 Upon reaching Kalpa, after spending some leisure time, we'll head out to visit the 3000-year-old Kalpa Monastery and the Suicide Point which offers a picturesque view of the Kailash ranges.
- 📍 Post-check-in, Dinner will be served followed by an overnight stay in Kalpa

Transfer from Kalpa to Kaza via Nako - Tabo - Ka loops

- 📍 Wake-up early morning & after breakfast start your journey to Spiti Valley.
- 📍 Enter Spiti valley through Sumdo Border. Visit Nako Tabo villages en route Kaza.
- 📍 Cross the Ka loops en route Kaza.
- 📍 Reach Kaza by evening.
- 📍 Check-in to the campsite.
- 📍 Dinner & sleep overnight.

DAY-5

Spiti Sightseeing | Key Monastery-Hikkim-Langza

- 📍 Being remotely located atop a hill overlooking endless plains, the Key Monastery is a world-famous center for learning and is an obvious choice for those seeking peace and calm.
- 📍 Further, drive to the highest suspension bridge in Asia – The Chicham Bridge.
- 📍 Next stop would be the highest village in Asia – Komic, situated at a height of 4513 m
- 📍 Later, we drive to Hikkim, where we have a chance to send postcards from the world's highest post office!
- 📍 At Langza, walk back to the prehistoric era when Spiti was submerged by the Tethys Sea
- 📍 Overnight at Kaza.

DAY-6

Depart for Chandra Taal

- 🌀 Depart for Chandra Taal Lake.
- 🌀 On the way, take a pit stop for snacks at Losar, the last village of Spiti Valley.

- 🌀 Dinner and stay in tents under the gaze of a million stars and the Milky Way Galaxy

Note: If the weather conditions don't permit us to stay in the camps near the Chandratall lake, we'll stay in the Batal region instead.

- 📍 En-route, we'll be passing through the iconic Atal Tunnel. Upon reaching Manali, we'll leave our bikes behind and check into our designated stay. Evening free for leisure and Old Manali Café Crawl (Lazy Dog, Café 1986, Rocky's Café etc.)
- 📍 Dinner will be served in the evening followed by an overnight stay in Manali.

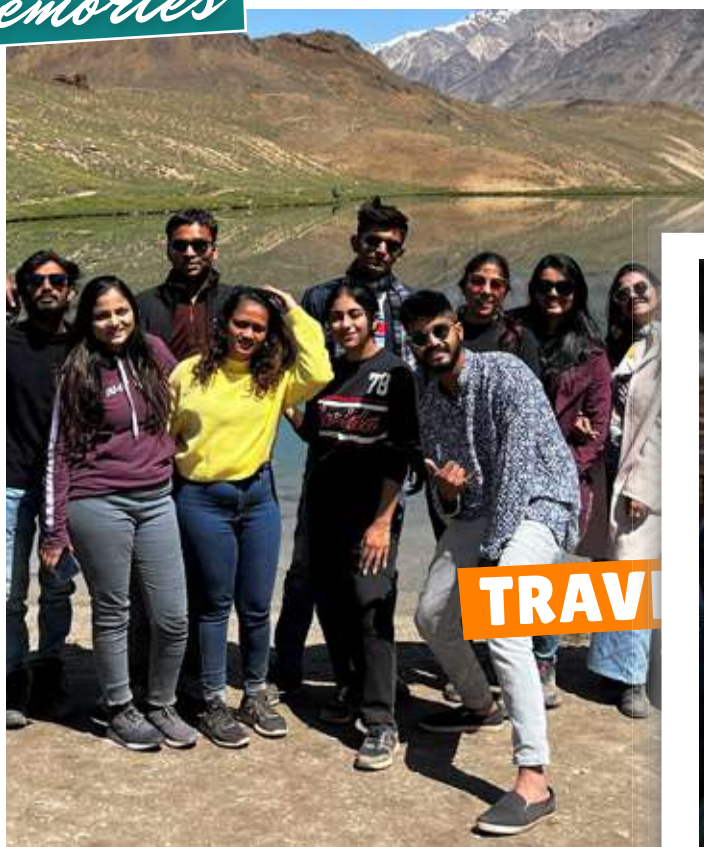


