#### By Rail





Another Alternative is New Delhi Railway Station is one through which most trains arrive & depart from Delhi and is located in Paharganj, near Connaught Place.



DAY-1

**Tour Begins!** 

Departure from Delhi to Manali



- The group will assemble at the pick-up point by 07:00 PM (tentative)
- We'll meet the team captains and a small tour briefing session will be conducted.
- After which, we'll head out on an overnight journey to Manali.

Note: The pickup point would be Majnu Ka Tila (tentative).

#### Manali Arrival


Manali Self Exploration Day



- Reach Manali by morning and check-in to the Hotel.
- After having breakfast and some leisure, feel free to explore the local area of Manali according to the place that interests you.
- You can visit the Mall road, Hadimba Temple, Old Manali for some good cafes to chill or Vashisht temple for the Hot water Spring.
- O Come back to the hotel by evening.
- Observe the stay and overnight stay.

#### **Drive Manali to Kaza**

via Atal Tunnel & Kunzum La



- ♠ Early morning, we start our journey to the valley of the Gods Lahaul & Spiti!
- Crossover to Lahaul by crossing the Engineering Marvel Atal Tunnel, and watch the terrain shift from lush green valleys to brown arid desserts.
- At 14,931 ft we cross another high altitude pass & the gateway to the Spiti Valley – Kunzum La.
- On the way, visit the highest suspension bridge in Asia The Chicham Bridge. We continue our drive through the stunning landscape to reach Kaza by evening.
- O Dinner & overnight stay in camps.

#### Spiti Sightseeing

Visit Dhankar Monastery & Pin Valley



- After Breakfast, first head towards Dhankar village and cover Dhankar Monastery which offers a spectacular view of confluence of Spiti & Pin river.
- Declared a national park in 1987, Pin Valley has altitudes ranging from 11,000 to 20,000 feet and is home to at least 12 endangered snow leopards.
- In addition, other animals indigenous to the region are the Siberian Ibex, Bharal, Weasel, Red Fox, and Marten. Birds such as the Pika, Griffon, Golden Eagle, Bearded Vulture, Chukor, and Raven can be spotted flocking to the skies of the picturesque valley.
- We first visit the Tailing hanging bridge and then the beautiful hamlet of Mud – the last motorable village of the Pin Valley.
- Overnight stay at Kaza.

#### **Spiti Sightseeing**

Visit Key Monastery, Chicham Bridge, Hikkim, Komic & Langza



- Being remotely located atop a hill overlooking endless plains, the Key Monastery is a world famous center for learning and is an obvious choice for those seeking peace and calm.
- Further, drive to the highest suspension bridge in Asia The Chicham Bridge.
- The highest village in Asia Komic, situated at a height of 4513 m, has a population of 84 people & is cut off from rest of world for most parts of year.
- Later, we drive to Hikkim, where we have a chance to send postcards from the world's highest post office!
- At Langza, walk back to the prehistoric era when Spiti was submerged by the Tethys Sea, as you explore a land very rich with fossils of Marine animals and plants which were here millions of years ago.
- Overnight at Kaza.

#### **Drive Kaza to Chandra Taal**

Via Losar & Kunzum La



- We start tracing our steps back towards Manali.
- O However, make one last stop to witness another Spitian wonder Chandra Taal Lake.
- The mystical and beautiful Chandra Taal Lake or the Moon Lake is located at a height of 14,000 feet.
- The Chandra Bhaga mountain range forms a striking backdrop for the lake, which changes appearance according to the pictures painted in the sky.
- Later check in to the Campsite near Chandra Taal Lake, and overnight stay at the tents under the gaze of a million stars and the Milky Way Galaxy.

Note: If the weather conditions don't permit us to stay in the camps near the Chandra Taal lake, we'll stay in the Batal region instead.

#### **Chandra Taal to Manali**

Evening Departure to Delhi via Volvo



- Today, we commence our way back on the Manali Kaza Road.
- We pass through some more stunning landscapes and reach Manali by afternoon.
- After some rest, we board the Volvo to Delhi and reach by next morning with lots of amazing memories to remember for a lifetime!

#### Tour Concludes!

#### Reach Delhi by morning

- We will reach Delhi early morning at 9:00AM (tentative).
- The group will part ways with fond memories from the trip.


