
about the Tour!

By Road




One of the best Options will be through Buses as it is well connected to cities like Jaipur, Agra, Alwar, Dehradun, & even Kathmandu among others





DAY-1

Delhi to Shimla (AC Volvo)

Overnight Journey | Tour Begins!



- The group will assemble at the pick-up point by 8:00 PM (tentative)
- We'll meet the team captains and a small tour briefing session will be conducted.
- After which, we'll head out on an overnight journey to Shimla.

Note: The pickup point would be Majnu Ka Tila/ Kashmiri Gate (tentative).

DAY-2

Drive Shimla to Chitkul/ Sangla

Last Inhabited Village on Indo - Tibetan Border

⌚ (225 Kms, 9 Hrs Drive Approx)



- ⌚ Early in the morning, we'll arrive in Shimla via the Hindustan-Tibet highway.
- ⌚ We'll be changing our transportation from bus to Tempo Traveler at this point and will head out for Chitkul/ Sangla.
- ⌚ Upon reaching Chitkul/Sangla, we will check into our hotels where we will indulge in group bonding exercises.
- ⌚ Dinner followed by an overnight stay in Chitkul/ Sangla.

Note: We'll stay in Sangla if the harsh weather doesn't allow us to stay in Chitkul.

DAY-3

Depart Chitkul/Sangla to Kalpa

Drive On One Of The Toughest Roads In The Country

⌚ (50 Kms, 3 Hrs Drive)



- ⌚ After breakfast, we will head towards Kalpa which is known for its scenic landscapes. On the way we will explore the small town of Reckong Peo town, serves as the perfect pit stop. If the weather gods are in your favor, you will be able to catch a glimpse of Kinner Kailash Peak.
- ⌚ We will also visit Kamru Fort en-route Kalpa if time permits.
- ⌚ Upon reaching Kalpa, after spending some leisure time, we'll head out to visit the 3000-year-old Kalpa Monastery and the Suicide Point which offers a picturesque view of the Kailash ranges.
- ⌚ Post-check-in, Dinner will be served followed by an overnight stay in Kalpa.

DAY-4

Drive Kalpa to Nako

Spin 500 Yrs. Old Prayer Wheel Made Of Yak Skin At Nako

⌚ (100 Kms, 5 Hrs Drive Approx)



- ⌚ After having breakfast, we'll continue our journey towards Nako, a tiny hamlet situated in the trans-Himalayan ranges.
- ⌚ En route, we will make a pit stop at Khab, the site of the union between the Sutlej and Spiti rivers.
- ⌚ In Nako, we'll visit the serene Nako Lake and pay our reverence at the Nako Monastery.
- ⌚ Afterward, we'll head back to our designated stays. Dinner and overnight stay at Nako.

DAY-5

Drive Nako to Kaza via Dhankar

Admire the Beautiful Architecture of Dhankar Monastery

⌚ (110 Kms, 5 Hrs Drive Approx)



- ⌚ Post breakfast, we will head towards the headquarters of Spiti which is Kaza.
- ⌚ En route to Kaza, which serves as the connective link between the districts, we will find ourselves surrounded by many monasteries. We will visit the thousand-year-old Tabo Monastery followed by a visit to the Dhankar Monastery and the Dhankar Fort.
- ⌚ We'll reach Kaza before evening and will check in to our designated accommodations. The rest of the day is at leisure. However, travelers are free to explore the small town.
- ⌚ Dinner followed by an overnight stay at Kaza.

DAY-6

Spiti Sightseeing Day (Komic, Hikkim, Langza)

Send Out Postcards Stamped at Top of the World



- Post breakfast, we'll head out to visit the Key Monastery locally known as Kye Gompa, followed by Chicham Bridge which is Asia's highest bridge.
- Later in the day, we will visit the highest post office in the world, Hikkim. Afterward, we'll move towards Komic village which is one of the highest villages in the world connected by a motorable road.
- Last but not least, we will visit the land of fossils, Langza, and visit the Buddha statue that sits on top of a hill overlooking the village.

Finally, we'll head back to Kaza where we will have dinner & spend the night.

DAY-7

Kaza to Kalpa

Drive On One Of The Toughest Roads In The Country

⌚ (200 Kms, 7 Hrs Drive Approx)



- ⌚ After breakfast, we will start our return journey to Kalpa.
- ⌚ We will reach Kalpa by evening where we will have dinner followed by an overnight stay.

DAY-8

Depart Kalpa to Shimla

Beautiful Kinnaur Valley with Memories Etched in your Heart

⌚ (222 Kms, 8 Hrs Drive Approx)



- ⌚ After breakfast, we'll resume our return journey and head towards Shimla.
- ⌚ Upon reaching Shimla, we will board an overnight bus towards Delhi.

DAY-9

Delhi Arrival

Tour Concludes!

- After passing through the hairpin bends and beautiful scenery, you will reach back to Delhi in the morning. (Around 8:00 to 10:00 AM)
- Once you arrive in Delhi, your amazing trip to Winter Spiti Valley comes to an end.

Note: Book your return flight for this day after consulting with your handler.

- Travellers residing outside Delhi are suggested to book trains/flights reaching Delhi not later than 2 PM on the trip start date. Similarly, on trip end date, book returning flight/trains leaving post 4 PM.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. May cause itinerary change. We reserve the rights to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general well-being.
- The age limit of our group departures is 16 to 42 years due to the power packed itineraries that we provide to our travellers. We can customize trips for travellers beyond the mentioned age bracket.

Cancellation *policy*

We would love to host you, but in case you are unable to travel as planned and need to cancel your booking, do not worry. Our simple cancellation process makes sure you receive a quick confirmation and fast refunds.

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

- If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.




